**Jeypore, June:** Amid a sharp rise in electricity demand and frequent weather-related disruptions, TP Southern Odisha Distribution Limited (TPSODL) has intensified efforts to ensure reliable and quality power supply in Jeypore. With power demand increasing significantly in recent years, frequent and back-to-back Kalabaisakhi incidents recorded during this summer, the company has strengthened its network, deployed advanced monitoring systems, and enhanced emergency response mechanisms to maintain service reliability.

Over the last few years, electricity demand in Jeypore has witnessed a steady increase, driven by rapid urbanisation, expanding commercial activities, growth in the service sector, increasing use of electrical appliances, and rising consumer expectations for uninterrupted power supply. As one of the key economic centres of Southern Odisha, the city continues to experience growing energy requirements from residential, commercial, institutional, and small industrial consumers. Demand is particularly high during evening and night-time peak hours, placing additional pressure on the distribution network.

Adding to the challenge, the region has experienced frequent weather-related disruptions. During this summer, the Jeypore Circle has witnessed 53 Kalabaisakhi incidents, impacting power infrastructure and affecting electricity supply across large areas. Despite these recurring disturbances, TPSODL has ensured prompt restoration of power supply through dedicated field teams, round-the-clock monitoring, and robust contingency planning. During the same period, the circle has also recorded a 13 per cent increase in power demand compared to the previous financial year.

To maintain reliability under these challenging conditions, TPSODL has deployed dedicated maintenance teams, ensured adequate availability of critical materials, and strengthened its fault response mechanisms. The company has also urged consumers to report electricity-related issues promptly to facilitate quicker resolution and improve service delivery.

Jeypore city currently receives electricity through four Primary Substations — Old Control Room PSS, New Bus Stand PSS, Dangaguda PSS, and Randapalli PSS.

Together, these substations provide sufficient transformer capacity to meet the city's growing energy requirements. In addition, dedicated N-1 contingency arrangements have been established to ensure alternative power supply routes during emergencies, maintenance activities, or unforeseen outages, thereby enhancing reliability and reducing supply interruptions.

Further, a major step towards enhancing reliability has been the implementation of a full-fledged SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) system at Jeypore's three major Primary Substations (PSS) — Old Control Room PSS, New Bus Stand PSS, and Dangaguda PSS. The system enables real-time monitoring of network operations, faster fault identification, and quicker restoration of power supply.

In order to strengthen the distribution network and prepare for future growth, TPSODL has invested around ₹20 crore in Jeypore city's power infrastructure over the years. The company has augmented 27 distribution substations and established 13 new Distribution Substations (DSS), significantly improving network capacity and resilience.

The infrastructure enhancement works include upgradation of 6 circuit kilometres (CKM) of 11 KV lines, construction of 1.3 CKM of new link lines, enhancement of 2 CKM of 11 KV lines, installation of 2 CKM of covered conductors, deployment of 25 Fault Passage Indicators (FPI) in the 11 KV network and two FPIs in the 33 KV network, installation of 69 Low Tension Distribution Boxes, construction of 8.2 CKM of 33 KV link lines, installation of covered conductors in forest stretches and deployment of six Auto Reclosers each in both the 11 KV and 33 KV networks. Several other network improvement works, including installation and upgradation of Ring Main Units (RMUs), Air Break Switches (ABS), intermediate poles, LT bare conductors, and LT Aerial Bunched Cables (ABC), have also been carried out based on system requirements.

As part of its stakeholder engagement efforts, TPSODL recently held an interactive session at its Jeypore Circle Office with representatives of the Jeypore Chamber of Commerce & Industry (JCCI) and Jeypore Municipality. During the discussion, the stakeholders' concerns were addressed. TPSODL assured participants that all identified locations would be inspected and necessary corrective measures would be undertaken to improve both safety and service reliability.

Addressing the gathering, Mr. Manmath Nath Mishra, Additional Chief Engineer and Circle Head, Jeypore, explained the power supply chain from generation to distribution and highlighted the company's preparedness measures. He assured stakeholders that TPSODL's emergency response and restoration systems have been significantly strengthened over the years and urged consumers to have confidence in the company's efforts to restore power supply swiftly during network disruptions and extreme weather events.

"Jeypore is witnessing sustained growth in power demand, driven by rising economic activity, urban expansion, and changing consumer lifestyles. At the same time, frequent weather disturbances and peak-load conditions are creating new operational challenges. We have adopted a long-term approach to strengthen the network through infrastructure augmentation, technology deployment, and enhanced emergency preparedness. Our focus is not only on meeting today's demand but also on building a resilient and future-ready power system that can reliably support the region's growth for years to come. We also seek the continued cooperation of consumers and stakeholders in this collective effort," he said.

Jeypore has emerged as one of the most important commercial and service centres of Southern Odisha, catering not only to Koraput district but also to adjoining regions of Malkangiri, Nabarangpur, and parts of neighbouring Chhattisgarh. Rapid urbanisation, expanding trade and commerce, growth of educational and healthcare institutions, and increasing adoption of electrical appliances have contributed to a steady rise in electricity demand, making reliable power supply critical to the city's continued economic growth.

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TPSODL strengthens Jeypore power network amid rising demand, weather disruptions

TP Southern Odisha Distribution Limited (TPSODL) has stepped up efforts to strengthen power infrastructure and maintain reliable electricity supply in Jeypore amid rising demand and frequent weather-related disruptions. According to the utility, electricity demand in Jeypore has increased steadily in recent years due to urbanisation, growth in commercial activities, expansion of the service sector and rising use of electrical appliances. The Jeypore Circle has recorded a 13 per cent increase in power demand compared to the previous financial year. The region has also witnessed repeated

Kalabaisakhi storms this summer, with 53 such incidents reported in the Jeypore Circle. The weather events affected power infrastructure and disrupted electricity supply in several areas, prompting restoration efforts by field teams. To improve reliability, TPSODL has deployed dedicated maintenance teams, strengthened fault response mechanisms and ensured the availability of critical materials for emergency repairs. The company has also urged consumers to report electricity-related issues for quick resolution.

Jeypore currently receives power through four primary substations — Old Control Room, New Bus Stand, Dangaguda and Randapalli. The utility has also established contingency arrangements to provide alternative power supply routes during maintenance work and outages. As part of its network modernisation efforts, TPSODL has implemented a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system at three primary substations in Jeypore to enable real-time monitoring, faster fault

detection and quicker restoration of power supply. The company said it has invested around Rs 20 crore in strengthening Jeypore's power infrastructure over the years. The works include augmentation of 27 distribution substations, establishment of 13 new substations, upgradation of power lines and installation of equipment aimed at improving network capacity and reliability. Recently, TPSODL held an interaction with representatives of the Jeypore Chamber of Commerce & Industry

(JCCI) and Jeypore Municipality to discuss power supply issues and infrastructure requirements. The utility said concerns raised during the meeting would be examined and necessary corrective measures taken. Addressing the meeting, Additional Chief Engineer and Circle Head, Jeypore, Manmath Nath Mahan said the company had strengthened its emergency response and restoration systems and was focusing on developing a resilient power network to meet the region's growing electricity demand.

डोन से बिजली लाइनों की निगरानी, छह मोबाइल सब-स्टेशन और विरोध कंट्रोल सिस्टम से होगी त्वरित बहाली

हो, इसके लिए पोल, कंडक्टर और वायरों एबी केवल जैसे आवश्यक सामग्री पहले से ही विभिन्न स्थानों पर उपलब्ध करा दी गई है। रात के समय निर्माण सरभत कार्य के लिए जलौक दिव्योदन में 25 आस्का लाइट और 19 डीजी सेट भी रखे गए हैं। 24 घंटे निगरानी, उपभोक्ताओं को हा पर मिलेगी जानकारी- बिजली नेटवर्क को लगातार निगरानी के लिए बरहामपुर स्थित पावर सिस्टम कंट्रोल सेंटर तथा रायगड़ा, फुलबनी और जेयपुर के एरिया पावर सिस्टम कंट्रोल सेंटर चौकीमें घंटे कार्यरत रहेंगे। आधुनिक स्वच्छ प्रणाली के माध्यम से 252 प्राथमिक 33/11 केबी सब-स्टेशन को निरंतर टाइम मॉनिटरिंग को माध्यम। उपभोक्ताओं को सूचना के लिए आईबीआरएस, एसएसएस आउट और 9777774699 मिस्ड कॉल सेवा सक्रिय रखी गई है। वहीं, टोल फ्री नंबर 1912 और 1800-2026 पर 24 घंटे कॉल सेंटर सेवा उपलब्ध होगी।

Considering the geographical challenges of Southern Odisha, including dense forests, remote hilly regions, and difficult terrain, TPSODL has strengthened its emergency response systems and network infrastructure to effectively manage any monsoon-related exigencies. To strengthen emergency response capabilities, six mobile distribution substations and two tower wagons have been positioned at strategic locations to address outages and disruptions caused by tree falls or adverse weather conditions.

Additionally, 20 ASKA lights and 19 DG sets have been made available in each division to facilitate uninterrupted repair and maintenance work during night hours.

As part of its network strengthening initiative, the company has already installed 2,529 interposing poles across its operational area. A key highlight of this year's preparedness is the drone-based survey of 11kV and 33kV lines, enabling early identification of vulnerable points, particularly in remote hilly and forest regions.

To ensure continuous monitoring and operational efficiency, the Power System Control Centre (PSCC) at Bharampur and Area Power System Control Centres (APSCCs) at Rayagada, Phulbani, and Jajpur are functioning round-the-clock. These centres are monitoring 252 nos. of 33/11 kV primary substations in real time through an advanced SCADA system.

Consumer service mechanisms have also been strengthened with IVRS-enabled systems, SMS alerts, and a dedicated missed call service (9777774659) to keep consumers informed about outages and restoration updates. In addition, TPSODL's 24x7 toll-free service through toll-free numbers 1912 and 1800-2026 are ensuring prompt consumer assistance and swift emergency response.

Further reinforcing its commitment towards service quality and transparency, TPSODL continues to publish reliability information at SAIFI and SAIDI online. A dedicated 33kV control desk has also been activated to ensure seamless coordination among departments, even in the most remote locations.
